I will be able to discuss celebrations that myself and others participate in.


I will be able to join in discussions about stars and space.


**Beebots** are robots that can follow instructions that are **programmed** into them. Perhaps you could practise by giving your child a set of three instructions and observing if they remember them!


## Diwali – Hindu festival of lights Sunday 31st October 2024
