Key Vocabulary

Heading – a title of the instructions, usually including what it is you will achieve after following the instructions

Imperative Verbs/Bossy Verbs – an action word that gives a command (**put, hold, make, do, stop, measure, draw**)

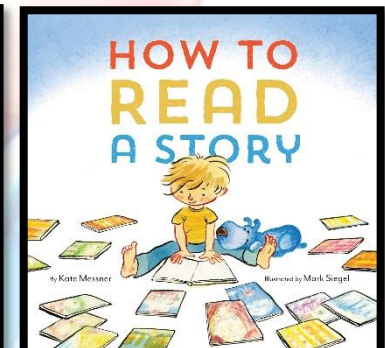
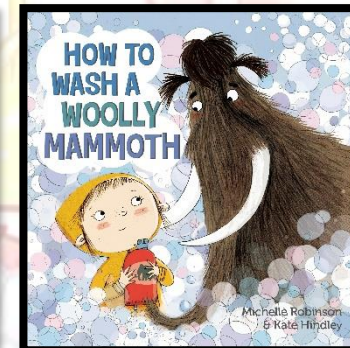
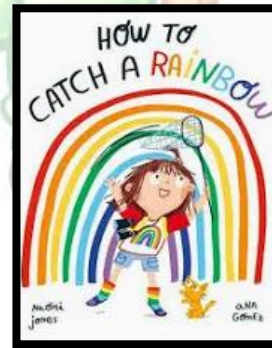
Time adverbials – words that describe when, how often, or for how long an action occurs (**first, next, then, after that, finally**)

Conjunctions – a word that joins two sentences together (**and, but, because, or, however**)

Adverb – a word that describes the verb (**gently, quickly, loudly, neatly, bravely**)

Adjectives – a describing word (**tiny, delicious, colossal, dizzy, short, bright**)

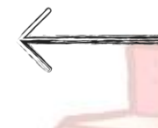
