

Reception – Knowledge Organiser Literacy – Summer Term 1 Our Precious Planet -If Sharks Disappeared...

Key Vocabulary:

CVCC fiction ascender
CCVC non-fiction descender
CCVCC fact vowel

Prior learning:

I can read Phase 1 and 2, and some phase 3, graphemes and say the sounds for them.

I can recognise some tricky words.

I can blend sounds I read into CV and CVC words.

I can begin demarcating sentences with capital letters and full stops.

I can form letters more accurately.

I can read a text independently.

I can sight read more high frequency words.

Now that we know all of the Reception phonemes (sounds) we will spend the summer term practising using them! This half-term we will be learning how to write CVCC, CCVC and CCVCC words









The **C** stands for **consonant** and the **V** stands for **vowel**!

Milestones:

I will be able to read and write CCVC, CCVC and CCVCC words.

I will be able to write a non-fiction report.

I will be able to write letters with clear ascenders and descenders.

I will begin to check my own sentences for demarcation with capital letters and full stops.




Our Write Stuff focus will be **non-fiction** — that means it is informative or factual.

Our key text this half term:



Letters with ascenders reach up higher than the average letter:

bdfhklt

Letters with descenders reach down underneath the line they're sat on:

gjpqy

Some letters don't have an **ascender** or a **descender**:

aceimnorsuvwxz
