Our fine motor skills will be put to the test as we design, sew and make our own embroidery art.

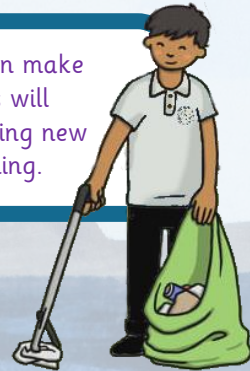
