**Seasons** – As the year passes there are regular changes in the weather. This cycle of change is divided into four parts, which are called seasons.

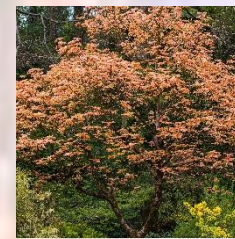
**Deciduous** – These trees lose their leaves in the Autumn.
