Key Vocabulary

Seasons – As the year passes there are regular changes in the weather. This cycle of change is divided into four parts, which are called seasons. They are **autumn**, **winter**, **spring** and **summer**.

Daylight – Daylight is when it is light outside. The amount of daylight changed with each season.

Weather – The weather includes temperature outside, how windy it is and rainfall (how much it rains). We can also describe cloud, sun and snow.

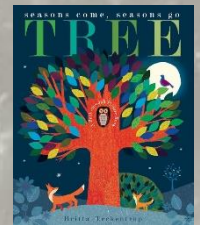
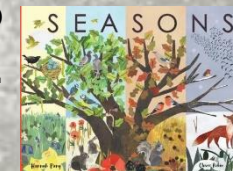
